<b>Writing Style</b>	Word choice exhibits effective strong verbs, specific details, memorable phrases, and striking images. Sentence structure uses a variety of lengths and structural variety to create the natural flow of speech. All paragraphs are focused on one clear topic sentence. (10 pts).	Word choice exhibits effective verbs, some details, a few memorable phrases, and images. Sentence structure uses a few different lengths and some structural variety to create the natural flow of speech. Most paragraphs are focused on one clear topic sentence. (7 pts).	Word choice exhibits a few effective verbs, some details, no memorable phrases, and few images. Sentence structure is generally the same length and little structural variety. A few paragraphs are focused on one clear topic sentence. (5 pts).	Word choice exhibits an almost no effective verbs, few details, no memorable phrases, and no images. Sentence structure is the same length and no structural variety. Most paragraphs are not focused on one clear topic sentence. (3 pts).
